



Dog Bite Survey Participation & Data Use Agreement

I. Definitions

- A. Aggregate data – the combined data collected from all agencies participating in the Dog Bite Survey.
- B. Coalition for Living Safely with Dogs (“CLSD”) – A group of agencies and organizations coming together to reframe the civic conversation about living with dogs. See attached member list.
- C. Colorado Association of Animal Control Officers (“CAACO”) – Professional association for Colorado’s animal control officers.
- D. Dog Bite Survey – the survey of dog bites in Colorado sponsored by CLSD and CAACO.
- E. Individual agency data – Dog bite data collected by each of the agencies participating in the Dog Bite Survey.

II. Parties to the Agreement

This agreement is executed by and applies to participants in the Dog Bite Survey and members of CLSD. By consenting to the terms of this agreement, the parties understand that participation in the Dog Bite Survey is contingent upon compliance with requirements listed herein.

III. Ownership of Data

- A. Aggregate data collected via the Dog Bite Survey shall be the sole property of the Coalition for Living Safely with Dogs.
- B. Individual agency data shall be the sole property of the agency that collected it.
- C. By participating in the survey, individual agencies have agreed to allow CLSD to use individual agency data collected through the Dog Bite Survey for the purposes of analyzing and reporting aggregate data.
- D. Neither participants in the survey nor individual CLSD members may release the aggregate data in any form to the members of the media, the public, or members of their organization without express permission from CLSD.

IV. Confidentiality & Distribution of Data

- A. Individual agencies shall retain the right to distribute their own data collected from representatives of their agency through the Dog Bite Survey.

- B. At all points during the survey period, individual agencies shall have access to their own data, in PDF form, by contacting the CLSD Data Collection Committee. When requesting individual agency data, agencies shall submit a written request (email is acceptable) and allow at least 3 business days for a response.
- C. Aggregate data is confidential and shall not be distributed publicly without the express consent of CLSD.
- D. Use of aggregate data without express permission from CLSD constitutes a violation of this agreement. Where CLSD believes that its aggregate data has been used improperly, it reserves the right to indicate this fact to the media and members of the public.
- E. CLSD members and Dog Bite Survey participants who share aggregate data without the express permission of CLSD shall no longer be permitted to participate in the Dog Bite Survey and shall not have access to the aggregate data, or any reports based on aggregate data.

V. Data Analysis

- A. CLSD reserves the sole right to analyze and report on the aggregate data collected via the Dog Bite Survey. The only authorized analyses of the aggregate data will be the one undertaken by CLSD one year from the date on which data collection commences and any subsequent quarterly analyses. After the initial year of data is reported and analyzed, data will be reported on a quarterly basis.
- B. The initial aggregate data analysis and any subsequent quarterly aggregate data analysis will be distributed free of charge to CLSD and to agencies participating in the survey.
- C. Any unauthorized analysis and reporting of the aggregate data will constitute a breach of this agreement. Participants who perform unauthorized analysis and reporting aggregate data without the express permission of CLSD shall no longer be permitted to participate in the Dog Bite Survey and shall not have access to the aggregate data, or any reports based on aggregate data.

VI. Electronic Access to Data

- A. CLSD shall maintain and monitor electronic access to the Dog Bite Survey data.
- B. CLSD reserves the right to restrict access to the Dog Bite Survey data
- C. All requests for electronic access to Dog Bite Survey data and analysis shall be made to CLSD.
- D. With the exception of the Dog Bite Survey administrator and one alternate CLSD member, CLSD members shall not have day-to-day access to individual agency data or aggregate Dog Bite Survey data, but shall receive copies of the aggregate data in quarterly or annual report forms.

VII. Counterparts & Electronic Acceptance

This agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same agreement. One or more of the counterparts may be executed electronically. For the purposes of this agreement, a party's acceptance via electronic means, such as facsimile or e-mail, shall be binding.
